On the edge of the Teutoburg Forest, the Jugenndorf - Christophorus School Versmold lies between the university cities of Münster, Bielefeld and Osnabrück. The school consists of a combination of preparatory school and middle school, with a special branch to help with the development of young foreigners, immigrants and asylum seekers. Our school and boarding complex, with its dormitories for boys and girls, give each pupil the possibility of an education corresponding to his or

her abilities. The school also offers numerous after-school activities.

The principles we live and work by

- Boys and girls live together in respective dormitories in order to experience living together on a Christian basis.
- We learn together at school in lessons and during the extra curricular activities.
- We experience life together at school, in the dormitories, doing sports, in our free time, in order to enhance and improve our social competence.

Our special profile

We are a Christian orientated school with an emphasis on the fine arts, with choirs, which undertake annual tours in Germany and abroad, voice training, an orchestra school, a music club and an orchestra.

School Type:

1. State recognized preparatory school (grades 5-13)
Language structure: from grade 5: English; from grade 7: Latin or French; from grade 9: Latin or Russian; from grade 11: English (beginners), Latin, Russian, Polish.
Individual advice on progress by the school, extra tuition and alignment courses in special classes, close co-operation with the councilors of the boarding house, various options for courses of all levels in the upper grades, fine arts class.
2. State recognized middle school (grades 5-10)
Language structure: from grade 5: English; from grade 7: French offered.
Streaming from grade 9 into Science, Technology, Social Science and Economics, Foreign Languages, Sports branches.
Individual advice on progress by the school, close co-operation with the councilors of the boarding house, special teaching, additional after-school groups, assistance in choosing vocational direction.
3. State recognized secondary modern school with a special section for returned German expatriates. Languages: English, Russian, Polish as a first foreign language.
Language assessment exam instead of a first foreign language.

Individual advice on progress by the school, extra tuition and alignment courses, special teaching, intensive individual tutoring, close co-operation with the councilors of the boarding house, assistance in choosing vocational direction.

Additional offers:

Supervision of school work in small groups, supplementary educational support, partner schools in the USA, France, Latvia and Poland.

Extra-curricular activities:

Fine arts: choir, chamber music, flute group, brass group, voice training for singing and speaking, orchestra school ...

Religion: Christian Union , contemplation week, worship, social welfare work, pastoral care by the school chaplain.

Culture: talks, discussions, films, festivals, project days, theatre, musical events, seminars .

Sports: adventure sports, cycling, canoeing, hiking, horse-riding, soccer, handball, basketball, volleyball, weight-lifting, Jiu-Jitsu, swimming, gymnastics, chess, dancing, table tennis, athletics, relaxation through self-hypnosis.

Arts and crafts: pottery, batik, enamel work, silk painting, cookery, photography, information technology .
